STAGE REQUIREMENTS:

IMPORTANT: Please, contact us in case of smaller dimensions.

MASKING:	Italian drapery 2 pairs of black velour legs 2 black velour borders Additional masking to be confirmed			
FLOOR:	Wooden floor (no cement), <u>EVEN, WITHOUT ANY RAKE OR TRIP EDGES</u> We require a dance floor (i.e.: Rosco) on <u>uneven or damaged surfaces</u> .			
DURATION:	1 act, approximately 60 minutes			
TOURING STAFF:	2 Artists 1 Technician			

SET REQUIREMENTS:

Please, not that some of the following scenery elements could change regarding some venues.

• Piano : We ask to be provided on stage by a grand or a baby grand piano prior to our arrival on stage. The instrument has to be in good shape and tuned on 440 in the morning of the first show.

<u>N.B.</u> We ask permission for the actress to sit on top of the cover wich will remain close. The actress will access the top thru a stool. Her weight is 115 lb / 52 Kg

- Vidéo : During the performance, some videos are projected on a 3 feet diameter round screen provided by the company. The screen weight is less than 2,204 lb. / 1 Kg. Distance for these projections can be adjusted. We ask to hang the provided screen on the same pipe as the backdrop.
 We are self suficient in terms of video projection as we travel with our own projector and cables whowever most of the times, and after checking its specificities, we use the local house video projector
 - and lines.
- Stool: We ask to be provided by a 18 inches high stool on stage.
- Mirror : Sometimes when the dressing room has no direct access from Stage left we ask to be provided by a small mirror set on the left wing.

COMMUNICATION REQUIREMENTS:

We require 4 Clearcom stations: sound board, lighting board, stage left and right.

SOUND REQUIREMENTS:

IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT THE SOUND OPERATOR BE IN THE HOUSE AND NOT IN A CONTROL ROOM. WE ASK THAT THE LIGHTING BOARD ALSO BE SET-UP NEXT TO IT.

1 pre-installed speaker system, adequate to properly fill the house, with full-range cabinets, 2 bass bins and appropriate amplifiers.

- 1 digital mixing console 16/4/2 (including equalization and effects) In case of a Analogic console
 - (4 individually assignable subgroups are needed on the console)
- 1 reverb unit (ex : lxp 15, spx 900),
- 1 compressor 2 channels (ex : aphex 108, dbx 160A),
- 4 graphic equalizer 31 band (F.O.H. and monitors)(ex : GQ1031)
- 1 Wireless Microphone Shure Beta SM58
- 1 Micorphone Shure SM58
- 2 stage monitors
- 2 microphone stands
- N.B. We may need to amplify the piano in some venues. We may need 2 active direct boxes in some venues.

LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS:

A light plot will be sent at the latest 1 month prior to the performance date to facilitate any pre-hang possibilities. Sound, video screen rigging point, masking informations will also be included.

We require a scale ground plan of the theatre as well as a section plan.

(We use AutoCAD 2015 for our drawings.)

MISCELLANEOUS:

We require lockable dressing rooms with mirrors, costume racks, toilets and showers. We ask that a key be given to our assigned stage manager.

We require a Steamer and also need access to an iron and ironing board prior to the performances and/or laundry facilities after every show in case of a fewer performances.

We ask for two small bottles of water for each performance. Also, water, coffee, fruits, nuts, cheese and juice in the green room as of the first day of set-up would be much appreciated,

We also require a parking area for our truck and/or minivan.

PERFORMANCES:

It is extremely important that our technician operate the performances, as cues are not called out during the show.

CREW REQUIREMENTS AND SCHEDULE:

-We require a minimum of 2 calls of four-hours to technical adjustements and a sound check.


-Please find a following proposed schedule for our 8 p.m. performance that can be modified to suit house or union rules.
